Community Ministries



Serving communities in crisis and people in need is central to EMO's community ministry. Our diverse program services include emergency food, refugee resettlement, affordable housing and parent mentoring, as well as social services. For the past two years, approximately 1,460 volunteers served more than 50,000 Oregonians in need, through EMO's community ministry programs.

Public Policy Advocacy

EMO believes that we are called to order our public life in ways that promote justice and compassion, ensuring that all Oregonians are able to live lives full of possibility. We are committed to a vision of the world in which there is no suffering, injustice, violence or exploitation. We have faith that such a world is not only possible, but is our responsibility to help bring into being. EMO's public policy advocacy helps to train and engage people so that they may participate in this important aspect of our ministry.



Theological Education & Dialogue



EMO's theological education and dialogue programs help congregations and individuals deepen their own faith and ecumenical commitments and better understand those of their neighbors. Each year we offer workshops, discussions, lectures, presentations, celebrations and vigils to celebrate Christian unity, foster interfaith relations and explore ethical and moral issues.

Environmental Ministries

EMO's Interfaith Network for Earth Concerns connects, informs and empowers people, congregations and religious institutions to work for justice, care and renewal of creation. Focus areas in 2001-02 included food security, sustainability, global warming (Oregon Interfaith Global Warming Campaign) and energy conservation (through Oregon Interfaith Power and Light).


Dear Friends,

High unemployment and hunger rates, terrorist attacks on Sept. 11, 2001, five special sessions of the Oregon Legislature in 2002 and the war in Iraq have greatly increased the need for Ecumenical Ministries of Oregon's (EMO) witness and service. We have been stretched and pulled, at times, not knowing if we can meet the responsibilities before us. Along with many other denominations, congregations and non-profits, we experienced a decrease in available income in the face of increased need.





2001 Board President

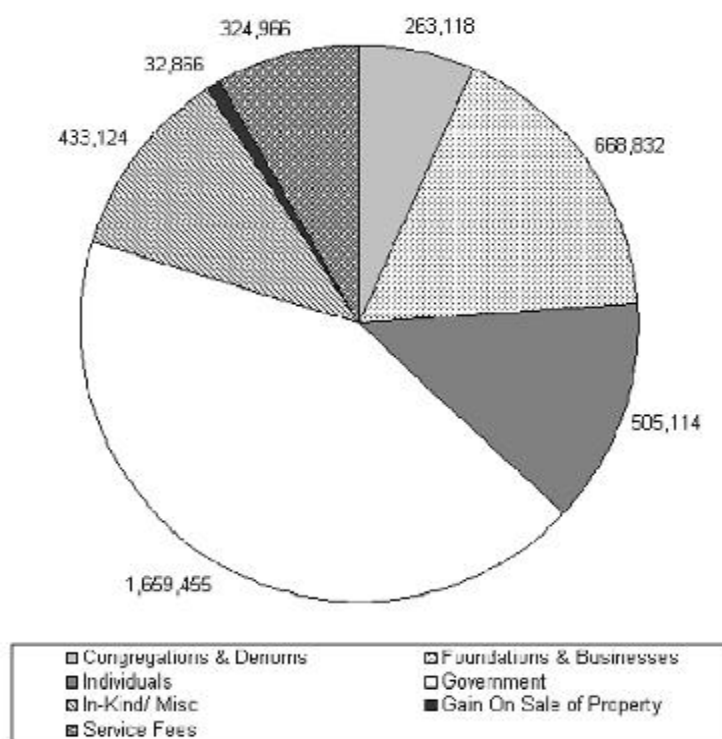

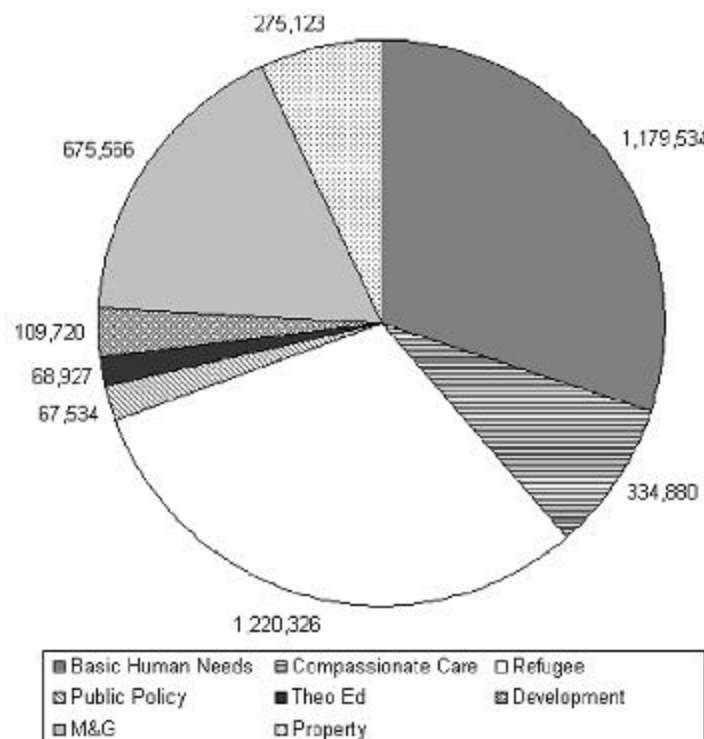
2001 Revenues

\$3,887,475



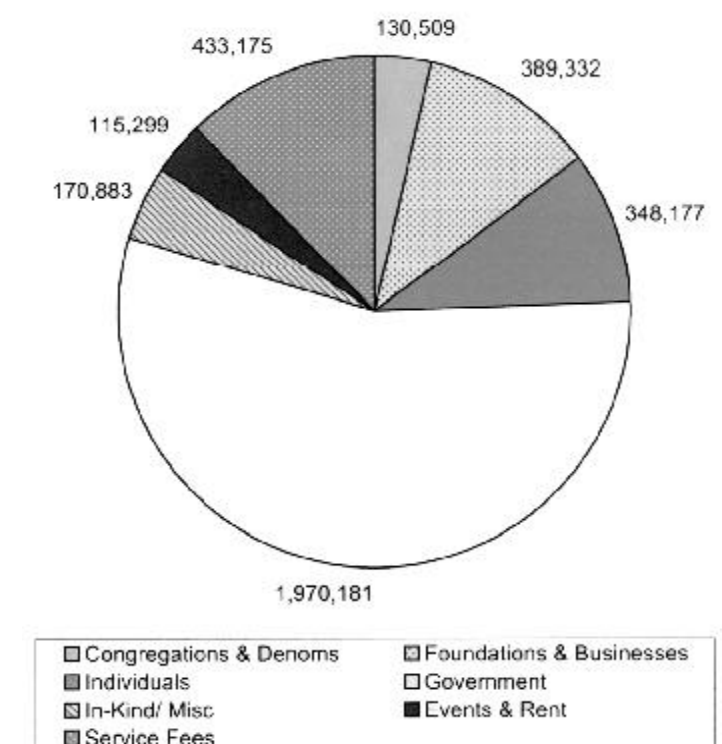
2001 Expenses

\$3,931,610



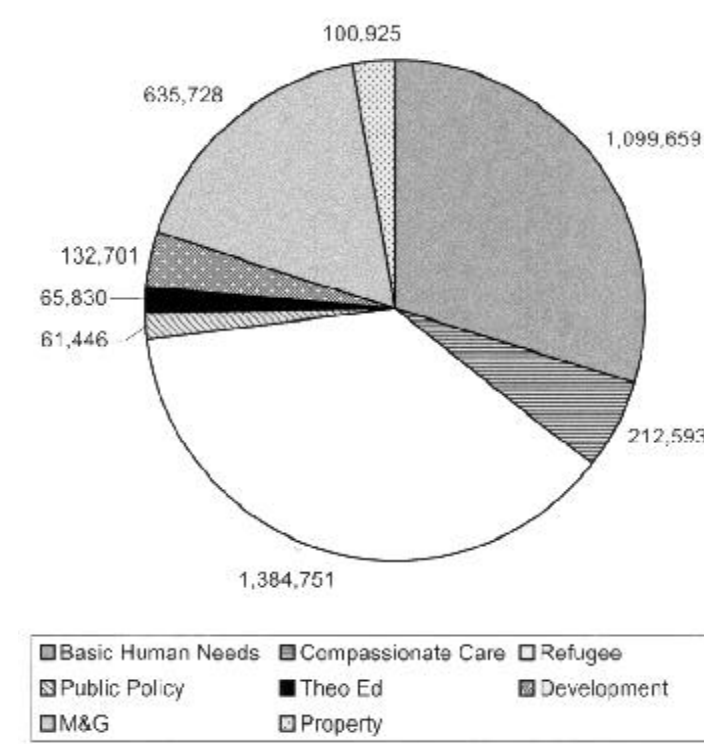
2002 Revenues
