



## Affordable Housing

*Ecumenical Ministries of Oregon has a long history of developing and advocating for affordable housing and is dedicated to filling the housing needs of those less fortunate by providing the services listed below.*

**Patton Home** is a beautiful and gracious 100-year old single-room occupancy residence in north Portland offering drug- and alcohol-free housing for up to 63 low-income residents.

**Shared Housing** provides affordable housing opportunities through a referral and matching service, bringing together those who need affordable housing with people who have homes and need help with rent, household chores or personal care.



**Second Home**—a collaboration between EMO's Shared Housing and the Beaverton School District's Family Service Center, Beaverton Dispute Resolution Center, Luis Palau Association and local congregations—matched nine unaccompanied, homeless students with volunteer home-providers in 2011.

*Affordable Housing in 2011 ... The Patton Home provided affordable drug- and alcohol-free housing for more than 63 individuals who were in various stages of recovery from substance abuse, transitioning from homelessness, or striving to maintain their personal independence* ■ *Shared Housing provided 167 clients 1,510 months of housing for the year; the Second Home project provided 51 months of housing for homeless youth.*

## Public Policy Advocacy

EMO believes that we are called to promote justice and compassion, ensuring that all Oregonians are able to live their lives full of possibility. EMO's **Public Policy Advocacy** helps train and engage people so that they may participate in this important aspect of our ministry.

EMO's advocacy network **Christians for Peace and Justice** unites individuals, congregations and religious organizations from different denominations across the state who are committed to advocating for social justice as witnesses to the public policy process on a state and national level.

## Hunger, Nutrition & Social Support

*Serving communities in crisis and people in need is central to EMO's basic human needs programs, which are listed below.*

**Food Services/Delizioso Catering** prepares nutritious meals for clients at the HIV Day Center and Daily Bread Express, residents at the Patton Home and students at local schools. The program also runs a catering service, providing outstanding and affordable food for events.

**HIV Services** offers a wide range of assistance for people living with HIV/AIDS. The HIV Day Center provides meals, counseling, recreational therapy, computers, phones, laundry, clothing and showers. The Daily Bread Express is the only program in Portland that delivers meals to home-bound individuals living with HIV/AIDS.

**Northeast Emergency Food Program (NEFP)** provides nutritionally-balanced food for people in critical need and works to develop neighborhood-based solutions to secure access to adequate, affordable and healthy foods.



At the HIV Day Center, 34 volunteers spent 4,524 hours providing a variety services—from tutoring clients with their reading skills (above), and leading art sessions, to providing massage therapy, haircuts and foot care.

## Hunger, Nutrition & Social Support

*in 2011 ...* Food Services/Delizioso Catering produced 47,188 meals for HIV Day Center and Daily Bread Express clients, Patton Home residents and students at two local schools; many of these meals were prepared with fresh produce grown in the Patton Home garden ■ *HIV Services supported 323 individuals living with HIV/AIDS, who made 7,842 visits to the HIV Day Center; provided 18,586 meals to clients at the HIV Day Center and home-bound individuals through the Daily Bread Express; 12 interns provided over 790 hours of service for clients at the HIV Day Center* ■ **Northeast Emergency Food Program** provided more than 600,000 pounds of food and 48,000 items of clothing to approximately 11,000 individuals—this was accomplished with a network of 250 volunteer, three interns, 25 congregations and nonprofit organizations, 14 businesses, and over 200 individual financial supporters; established a 1,000 square-foot pantry garden with a grant from the Oregon Food Bank.

## Theological Education & Dialogue

EMO's **Theological Education & Dialogue** programs help congregations and individuals deepen their own faith and ecumenical commitments and better understand those of their neighbors. Each year, EMO offers workshops, discussions, lectures, presentations, celebrations and prayer vigils to celebrate Christian unity, foster interfaith relations, and explore ethical and moral issues. EMO also sponsors the Collins Lectures, an annual event designed to provide an opportunity for clergy and laity to explore issues related to religion and social ethics.

## Refugee & Immigration Ministries (RIM)

*Ecumenical Ministries of Oregon's Refugee and Immigration Ministries offer comprehensive and compassionate services to thousands of refugees and immigrants in the Portland metro area through the programs listed below.*

**Russian Oregon Social Services (ROSS)** gives assistance to Russian-speaking refugees and immigrants, including domestic violence services, breast and cervical health education, mental health counseling, ESL and computer classes, citizenship training, legal and tax assistance, dental care and more.

**Sponsors Organized to Assist Refugees** links sponsors with refugees before they arrive in the United States and helps sponsors welcome and assist the refugees in their adjustment to a new life in the Portland metro area.

**SOAR Legal** serves the law-related needs of the broader refugee and immigrant communities, providing low-cost immigration representation to immigrants and refugees in application processes.



Sponsors Organized to Assist Refugees provided services to 41 children and their parents last year through a new program, SAFRN (School Assistance for Refugee Newcomers), in collaboration with Lutheran Community Services, Catholic Charities, and Immigrant & Refugee Community Organization.

*Refugee & Immigration Ministries in 2011 ...* Russian Oregon Social Services offered direct services to 2,962 Russian-speaking individuals, including 310 victims of domestic and sexual violence and their children; 261 women received a free mammogram and over 3,500 received breast and cervical health education ■ **Sponsors Organized to Assist Refugees** resettled 257 refugees and 20 asylees, the majority of whom came from Cuba, Iraq, Bhutan and Burma ■ **SOAR Legal** initiated the "Voter Education Project," teaching newly naturalized citizens about the U.S. voting system and helping them register to vote; served 1,820 immigrants and refugees, and filed 152 applications for permanent residence, 85 for work permits, 307 for Naturalization and 70 for Family Reunification.
