Faith Partner Membership Dues Structure

As a covenantal membership association, all members are expected to support EMO financially. Designated for EMO's annual fund, recommended annual membership dues are based on member size:

- 100 or fewer members: \$120
- 101-250 members: \$200
- 251-500 members: \$300
- 501-1,000 members: \$400
- Over 1,000 members: \$500
