HOUSE BILL 2957

WHAT WILL IT DO?

- DIRECTS THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES TO DEVELOP GRANTS FOR ORGANIZATIONS TO PROVIDE FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO NONCITIZENS WHO QUALIFY FOR A PATHWAY TO RESIDENCY, CITIZENSHIP, OR PERMANENT PROTECTION
- \$1,500 FOR AN INCOME NO GREATER THAN \$60,000
- \$1,000 FOR AN INCOME GREATER THAN \$60,000 BUT NOT GREATER THAN \$70,000
- \$750 FOR INCOME GREATER THAN \$70,000 BUT NO GREATER THAN \$80,000

FUND FOR PATHWAYS TO LAWFUL PERMANENT STATUS



THE ISSUE



Pathways to Lawful permanent status are expensive & sometimes quite simply difficult for individuals who are not familiar with immigration law.

WHAT WILL HB 2957 DO?

Directs Department of Human Services (DHS) to establish a program to distribute funds to community-based organizations to provide financial assistance to noncitizens who do not possess valid immigration documentation, individuals with a pathway to adjustment of status, pathway to residency, and citizenship, so they may seek legal aid or submit their documentations.

House Bill 2957 passed the House Committee on Early Childhood and Human Services with unanimous support from committee members.
