Over more than 45 years of engagement with religious, nonprofit, and government programs, Linda has applied these values both locally and globally. She served for 10 years as Executive Minister of Justice and Witness Ministries in the national headquarters of the United Church of Christ (UCC), overseeing the church's work on human rights and racial, environmental, economic, and gender justice in the United States and
 around the world.
