2,548 consultations provided and **2,307** applications/petitions filed for low-income immigrants and refugees at **SOAR Immigration Legal Services**



3,688 days of housing and **11,064** meals provided to **19** **Second Home** students

53 survivors of domestic violence/sexual assault received housing assistance, ongoing case management support, safety planning, mental health counseling and more at **Slavic Oregon Social Services**



2.2 million pounds of food distributed to **42,000** households at **Northeast Emergency Food Program**

121,525 meals provided to **138** **HIV Services** clients living with HIV/AIDS

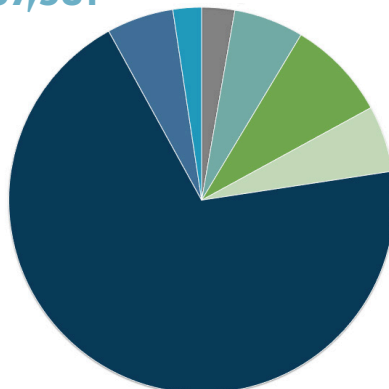


130 individuals attended our 2023 **Interfaith Advocacy Day** and met with **58** legislators
